Background

Galalent Limited trading as "Aberdovey Hillside Village" (AHV) (company registered number 019767701) ("we, our or us") manage a group of houses and apartments to provide self-catering accommodation and associated services and facilities at Aberdovey Hillside Village, Aberdovey, Gwynedd LL35 0ND.

The Data Controller

Under data protection legislation, which is currently the Data Protection Act 2018 and the General Data Protection Regulation ((EU) 2016/679, we are the data controller in respect of the personal data and this notice sets out;

Legal Basis for the Processing

We set out below the type of personal data about you that we process, why we need to process it and the legal basis for doing so:

To answer an enquiry about a holiday by telephone or email, through our website or by letter	Your name, postal, address, telephone number and email address.	The processing is necessary to send you information about AHV. The processing is at your request for you to consider whether to making a booking
To make a holiday booking and to manage your booking	Your name, postal, address, telephone number, email address and card payment details.	The processing is necessary in order to make the booking, i.e. for the performance of the contract between you and us for the holiday.
To send you marketing material by post or by email	Your name, postal address and email address	We will only use your personal data for marketing purposes if we have your consent to do so. We do not take credit references

Consent

How Long Will Your Data Be Kept?

If you make an enquiry do not book a holiday with us during the course of the subsequent 12 months, we will delete your data unless we have your consent to send you information about Aberdovey Hillside Village.

If you book a holiday with us, we will retain your data for a period of 7 years after the completion of your holiday with us to ensure that we can deal with any issues that you might raise because it is in our legitimate interest to do so.

We will delete any personal data that we hold about you for marketing purposes:

- immediately if you withdraw your consent to its use for this purpose;
- if you have opted to received marketing material by electronic means, on the expiry of three years after the date of your consent unless it has been renewed; and
- if you have opted to received marketing material by post, on the expiry of five years after the date of your consent unless it has been renewed

Sharing Your Personal Data

We may share your personal data with:

- Our accountants, solicitors and other professional advisers;
- Hillside Park Limited the owner of land and property that includes Aberdovey Hillside Village (the property)
- A prospective purchaser of AHV or the company that owns it or any lender that requires security over AHV or the company that owns it;
- Any person, company or other agency with which we are obliged by law to share the personal data.

Your Rights in Relation to Your Personal Data

You have the following rights in relation to the personal data we hold on you:

- a) the right to be informed about the data we hold on you and what we do with it;
- b) the right of access to the data we hold on you. More information on this can be found in our separate policy on Subject Access Requests;
- c) the right for any inaccuracies in the data we hold on you, however they come to light, to be corrected. This is also known as 'rectification';
- d) the right to have data deleted in certain circumstances. This is also known as 'erasure';
- e) the right to restrict the processing of the data;
- f) the right to transfer the data we hold on you to another party. This is also known as 'portability';
- g) the right to object to the inclusion of any information;
- h) the right to regulate any automated decision-making and profiling of personal data.
